## Position Description

Broadly, duties include coordination of day-to-day operations across the geographically dispersed M&O contractors, review and advise on matters pertaining to planning, integrating, and executing policies, programs, and procedures for development of guidance for resolving issues related to this weapons system.

At a minimum, the ideal candidate will have an in-depth understanding of the NNSA and Nuclear Security Enterprise (NSE) design and production sites and processes as well as a basic understanding of NNSA funding mechanisms. The individual will apply broad and diversified knowledge of respective nuclear weapons systems engineering, non-nuclear component realization, nuclear materials production and component development, product realization process, Phase X/6.X activities and deliverables, program controls and project management disciplines.

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This is a full-time contractor-support position located on-site at the NNSA offices in Albuquerque NM.
